Wall hanging with Mara Mesa

Combine 5 different techniques and the enjoyment of using your machine into one beautiful wall hanging to commemorate a great city.

The class features a watercolor sky, landscape elements are learned with the Alamo applique and pieced river walk. Create your own embroidery designs for the Tower of the Americas, bank, and river boat. The classroom has limited space so sign up early.

### Supply List for *Welcome to San Antonio*

#### 1. Foundation:

The finished size of the wall quilt is 36"x54" (without borders). You will need a foundation printed with 2 inch squares on one side and a heat-activated adhesive on the other. The total amount of foundation should measure 48"x72". You can make the wall quilt in a larger or smaller size, but you will need to have the capability to increase or decrease the size of the embroidery designs to be in scale with the size you choose.

#### 2. Fabric:

For the first class you will need to bring fabrics for the sky. If you plan to have a multicolor sky (as I did) you will need 4 or 5 fabrics that blend pleasingly. The fabrics should range from light, to medium, to darker medium, to darkest medium – or even a dark fabric. You will need ¼ yard of the lighter fabrics and a ½ yard of the darkest one. They do not need to be of the same color (mine go from blue to yellow to purple); nor do they need to look like a conventional sky. They can represent a sunrise with blues, yellows, and tangerines; or they can look like a sunset with golds and oranges and deeper blues. The sky in my wall hanging is only a suggestion – a launching point – from which you can follow your own creativity. If you prefer a uniform, traditional sky you can choose a range of blue fabrics or one of the many fabrics with clouds.

When considering a range of fabrics do not lay the bolts down side-by-side and flat. Rather stack the fabrics from lightest to darkest one on top of the other, and look at the edge of the bolts which are about 1 ½ inches wide – just like the squares will be in your quilt. Look for a pleasing “blend” of colors and textures.

Choose tone-on-tone fabrics that have some variation in color and pattern – very subtle patterns, swirls, lines etc. that do not systematically repeat. Avoid prints with distinct outlines; no one pattern should stand out. I chose several Fossil Fern fabrics by Benartex for my sky, and there are others with similar qualities. If you want to wait until the first class to select your sky fabrics I will be there a half-an-hour early and I will have some fabrics selected to give you ideas.

You will have time to search and shop for the fabrics for the bottom half of the quilt while you are working on the top half. I will have samples of the types of fabric to look for at the first class.

#### 3. Other Supplies:

- a. ruler, cutting mat and rotary cutter
- b. pins
- c. two sheets of tissue paper
- d. A piece of fabric the size of the sky to take your project home without dismantling it. If you have some flannel or a piece of vinyl tablecloth that is flocked on one side, that would be preferred.

Class Registration Policy



Payment is due at registration. After registering, make sure you receive a class confirmation form and supply sheet. Supplies & fabric are extra unless stated. Babies, family members or friends are not permitted in class unless stated for that class.

#### Refund policy

In the event that a class must be cancelled due to insufficient enrollment, individuals who registered for that class will be notified and a full refund will be mailed. Should a student cancel a class, refunds are available if requested ONE WEEK BEFORE THE FIRST CLASS. There will be a \$5.00 administrative fee applied to each class fee. No refunds can be given once a class or club has begun, no refunds will be given on kit fees.

All Mastery classes that have been paid for are non refundable. It is the responsibility of the student to take their classes as soon as they can after not attending.

There are no refunds on class fees for National Educators. Please find a friend to take your place and inform us of their name, so they can have their own name tag for class.
